Mayor Hill called the meeting to order at 6:00 p.m.

Approval of Minutes:

Ordinance No. 3212 (approved)

The motion was made by Council Member Johnson and seconded by Council Member Smith that **Ordinance No. 3212**, consider amending Chapter 1, *General Provisions*, Article 1.100, *Code of Ordinances*, Section 1.106(a), *General Penalty for Code Violations*, of the City Code of Ordinances, concerning a violation of the Specific Use Permit, be passed and approved. The motion passed 3-0 on a roll call vote: Council Member Johnson – “aye”; Council Member Smith – “aye”; Mayor Hill – “aye”.

ORDINANCE NO. 3212

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 1, GENERAL PROVISIONS, ARTICLE 1.100, CODE OF ORDINANCES, SECTION, 1.106(a), GENERAL PENALTY FOR CODE VIOLATIONS, OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

WHEREAS, in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, the City Council has conducted a public hearing for the purpose of considering the amendment to the Code of Ordinances for the City of Corsicana, Texas; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Corsicana (“City Council”) has determined that it is in the best interest of the City to amend its Code to provide for certain penalties for violation of a condition of a Specific Use Permit.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, that Chapter 1, *General Provisions*, Article 1.100, *Code of Ordinances*, Section 1.106, *General Penalty for Code Violations*, of the City Code of Ordinances, be amended to include the changes to hereafter read as follows:

**CHAPTER 1 – General Provisions
Article 1.100 – Code of Ordinances
Section 1.106 – General Penalty for Code Violations**

(a) Whenever in this code or in any ordinance of the City, an act is prohibited or is made or declared to be unlawful of an offense or a misdemeanor, or wherever in such code or ordinance the doing of an act is required or the failure to do any act is declared to be unlawful, and no specific penalty is provided therefor, the violation of any such provision of this code or any such ordinance shall be punished by a fine not exceeding five hundred dollars (\$500.00), except for:

(1) violations of municipal ordinances that govern fire, safety, zoning, public health and sanitation, including dumping of refuse, vegetation and litter violations in which the maximum fine shall be two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for each offense, and

(2) violations of traffic laws and ordinances which are punishable as a Class C misdemeanor shall be punished by a fine not to exceed two hundred dollars (\$200.00) and

(3) violations of a specific use permit or a condition imposed in connection with the granting of a specific use permit or a condition imposed in connection with the granting of a specific use permit shall be two thousand dollars (\$2,000.00) for each offense.

However, no penalty shall be greater or less than the penalty provided for the same or similar offense under the laws of the state.

(b) Each day any violation of this code or of any ordinance shall continue shall constitute a separate offense. Any violation of any provision of this Code of Ordinances which constitutes an immediate danger to the health, safety, and welfare of the public may be enjoined in a suit brought by the City for such purposes.

WHEREAS, the City agrees to contract with Navarro County to conduct and supervise City elections, which will promote the public welfare by increasing efficiency and promoting uniformity for elections; and

WHEREAS, the Cities, School Districts, College, and County agree to jointly share equipment and expenses as stated in the contract with the County.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, that the City's participation in the joint contract for election services between all Cities and all School Districts in Navarro County, Navarro College, and the County for the May 2, 2026, election is hereby approved.

RESOLUTION NO. 4596

A RESOLUTION OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, ADOPTING FINANCIAL POLICIES.

WHEREAS, the proposed Financial Policies, including: Capitalization Policy, Credit Card Data Policy, Financial Policy, Fraud Policy, Investment/Collateralization Policy, Purchasing Policy, Purchasing Card Policy, and Records Management Policy will provide sound guidelines in planning the City's financial future; and

WHEREAS, the Capitalization Policy will ensure that consistent and proper procedures are followed in the recognition of assets held and/or owned by the City and to maintain that a written requirement for the responsible authority of the City shall maintain financial and other records containing sufficient quantitative information in such a

manner as to sufficiently serve to safeguard these items as public investments and to assure stewardship of all such assets held in public trust; and

WHEREAS, the Credit Card Data Policy is required by the Payment Card Industry Data Security Standard Program and the City is committed to these security policies to protect information utilized by the City; and

WHEREAS, the Financial Policy will provide sound guidelines in planning the City's financial future, help ensure long-term financial stability a healthy financial position for the City; and

WHEREAS, the Fraud Policy will facilitate the development of controls that will aid in the detection and prevention of fraud or abuse against the City of Corsicana; and

WHEREAS, the Investment and Collateralization Policy will provide guidance for maximum security and the highest return in accordance with the Public Funds Investment Act, Chapter 2256, Texas Government code, the City Council of the City of Corsicana; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Policy guides employees in the purchase of all items and to avoid separate, sequential, and component purchases which are monitored by the State Attorney General's office for the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Purchasing Card Policy guides employees in the purchase of all items using the City Purchasing Cards and to avoid separate, sequential, and component purchases which are monitored by the State Attorney General's office for the State of Texas; and

WHEREAS, the Records Management Policy is to guide the efficient, economical, and effective control over the records management process from creation through distribution, according to requirements of the Texas Local Government Records Act; and

WHEREAS, these policies must be approved annually by City Council, with acknowledgement of said approval in the revision history.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, THAT the City of Corsicana Capitalization Policy, Credit Card Data Policy, Financial Policy, Fraud Policy, Investment/Collateralization Policy, Purchasing Policy, Purchasing Card Policy, and Records Management Policy is adopted, effective December 22, 2025.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, that the City Manager is authorized to execute a contract to place an order with Siddons Martin Emergency Group for the purchase of a 2025 Pierce Enforcer 107' Quint for an amount not to exceed \$1,896,765 with a delivery date of 11 to 12 months from order date.

Owner: Mr. W Fireworks Inc.
Applicant: Wayne Wildman

Comments: The owner requests that these properties be removed from the Extraterritorial Jurisdiction of the City of Corsicana, following the passing of Senate Bill 2038. The properties being requested to be removed from the City's ETJ and the applicant's petition are included for your review.

Staff have reviewed the request and found that the request is permitted as per S.B. 2038 and, because the owner of the property has filed and signed the petition, the City must release these properties from its ETJ. There are no current zonings of these properties. The Future Land Use Plan shows the surrounding property is Medium Density Residential (MDR).

Senate Bill 2038, passed during the Texas 88th Legislative Session (88R,2023), amended state law related to a city's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction (ETJ) effective September 1, 2023. Specifically, the bill creates processes for property owners or residents to petition a city for property to be released either directly or by election from the city's ETJ.

Notification letters were not sent to the surrounding property owners.

Recommendation: Consider the request to remove the above property from the City of Corsicana's Extraterritorial Jurisdiction.




Removal from ETJ – PID 50388 G0200 Gillen Est. Ranchitoes Lot 7 at 4212 West State Highway 22



 City Limits of Corsicana






