Dear Citizens:

The reconstruction of North 24th Street is progressing as planned. The utility relocations are complete. The final removal of the existing pavement was completed recently. The new pavement construction will begin the week of November 6. Travel between 1st Avenue and Elmwood will be restricted to local traffic only. The construction is projected to be complete in December as weather permits.

The reconstruction of West 14th Avenue from 18¹/₄ Street to 19³/₄ Street is underway. The new water line and sewer line is complete. The street will be reconstructed using City work force and is planned to begin as soon as weather permits. This work is being done under a CDGB grant from the Texas Department of Agriculture and the Housing and Urban Development branch of the Federal Government.

The 2017 Street Improvement Program ended this year with approximately \$1,223,433 spent on streets around town. Of this amount, \$837,155 was funded through the street improvement fee and \$386,278 was funded through Council appropriation from the General Fund.
