Dear Citizens:

You may have seen ongoing work at the intersection of Highway 22, Second Avenue, and North 37th Street over the past month. What you may not know is that there was a leak on the major 30" water line that brings water to the entire northwest side of town. This waterline provides several large customers, including Navarro Regional Hospital, doctors' offices, and the Collins Catholic School, with water. The leak was discovered under the pavement of Highway 22. In order to repair it, two large valves were installed on either side of the leak on the 30" line. Once these valves were installed, the line was slip lined with a new pipe and placed back in service. The repair was completed and most customers did not ever know the critical nature of the situation. There were many challenges and the project was costly. I would like to thank Terry Franks and the Public Works crew, Kyle Pritchett and the Environmental Services crew, and SKE Construction for all the work and dedication over the past weekend to complete the repairs and place the line back in service. Their work often goes unnoticed and is so important to the citizens of Corsicana.
