Dear Citizens:

During these trying times, citizens are still encouraged to conduct as much business as possible by phone or internet communication. On Monday, June 8, 2020, the Government Center will open the north end of the building to accept walk-in utility payments and to process building permits. The south side of the building will be open for Municipal Court business. All other departments may be contacted at 903-654-4800 if additional attention is needed. The Police Department lobby will be open for citizens that need records. The Senior Activity Center will open with limited capacity. Pioneer Village will open to groups less than 10. Pools and spray parks are scheduled to open June 13 with 25% capacity limitations.

The Library will open with new hours of operation and 25% capacity limitations. Please call 903-654-4810 to confirm hours of operation. Curbside service will continue through the month of June.

Based on the current State guidelines, the City Council Meeting scheduled for June 8 can be viewed by live broadcast on the City's website, with participation by telephone or teleconference. The meeting will not be open to the public.

Please remember that COVID-19 has not left the community. It is here and it is a very serious threat. Citizens are encouraged to continue to use good judgment and practice social distancing.
