**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF
CORNICANA, TEXAS, REPEALING AND REESTABLISHING
SECTION 1.1603, *HUNTING REGULATIONS* IN ITS ENTIRETY IN
CHAPTER 1, *GENERAL PROVISIONS*, ARTICLE 1.1600, *GENERAL
PARK REGULATIONS*, OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, that Section 1.1603, *Hunting Regulations*, in Chapter 1, entitled *General Provisions*, Article 1.1600, *General park Regulations*, of the City Code of Ordinances be repealed and reestablished and shall read as follows:

**CHAPTER 1: GENERAL PROVISIONS
Article 1.1600 – General Park Regulations
Section 1.1603 – Hunting Regulations**

It shall be hereafter unlawful to carry or discharge any firearms, firecrackers, rockets, torpedoes, or any other fireworks, air guns, BB guns, bows and arrows, slingshots, paint-ball guns, or any device which would or could project any object which would or could create a fire hazard or any hazard or danger to the public on any property owned or controlled by the City of Corsicana. This includes all city parks, sports complexes and the waters of Lake Halbert. The use of rifles, pistols or any type of firearm is prohibited on Lake Halbert or on any property owned by the City of Corsicana except as used by law enforcement for training. It shall be unlawful for any person to hunt on the waters or property owned or controlled by the City of Corsicana.

It shall be a defense to the prohibition against carrying a firearm within a city park if the person carrying the weapon has been issued a license to carry such weapon pursuant to Chapter 411, Subchapter H of the Texas Government Code, as amended, and the carrying of such weapon is not otherwise prohibited by other law.
