**AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF  
CORSICANA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 2, *ANIMAL CONTROL*,  
ARTICLE 2.100, *DEFINITIONS*, OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.**

**WHEREAS**, in accordance with the provisions of the laws of the State of Texas, the City Council has conducted a public hearing for the purpose of considering the amendment to the Code of Ordinances for the City of Corsicana, Texas.

**NOW, THEREFORE BE IT ORDAINED**, by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas, that Chapter 2, *Animal Control*, Article 2.100, *Definitions*, of the City Code of Ordinances are amended to read as follows:

**CHAPTER 2 – ANIMAL CONTROL**

**Article 2.100 – DEFINITIONS**

Dangerous Dog: Shall mean a dog that makes an unprovoked attack on a person, another dog, domesticated animal, or livestock that causes bodily injury and occurs in a place other than an enclosure in which the dog was being kept and that was reasonably certain to prevent the dog from leaving the enclosure on its own; or commits unprovoked act or acts in a place other than in an enclosure in which the dog was being kept and that was reasonably certain to prevent the dog from leaving the enclosure on its own and those acts cause a person to reasonably believe that the dog will attack and cause bodily injury to that person or another dog.
