

ORDINANCE NO. _____

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF CORSICANA, TEXAS, AMENDING CHAPTER 14, *ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*, ARTICLE 14.400, *REGULATION OF LAWFUL CONSUMPTION OF ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*, SECTION 14.407(d) OF THE CITY CODE OF ORDINANCES.

BE IT ORDAINED by the City Council of the City of Corsicana, Texas that Chapter 14, *Alcoholic Beverages*, Article 14.400 *Regulation of Lawful Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages*, Section 14.407(d), *Sale, Consumption on Premises of Municipal Buildings and City-owned Property Prohibited*, of the City Code of Ordinances shall be amended and hereafter read as follows:

CHAPTER 14 – *ALCOHOLIC BEVERAGES*

Article 14.400 - *Regulation of Lawful Consumption of Alcoholic Beverages*

Sec. 14.407 – *Sale, Consumption on Premises of Municipal Buildings and City-Owned Property Prohibited*

- (a) Except as set forth below, it shall be unlawful for any person to sell an alcoholic beverage on the premises of any municipal building or City-owned property.
- (b) Except as set forth below, it shall be unlawful for any person to consume an alcoholic beverage on the premises of any municipal building or City-owned property.
- (c) The prohibitions contained in Article 1.2000, prohibiting the possession of alcoholic beverages, or being under the influence thereof, on the grounds of any City-owned lakes, or the adjacent grounds, are hereby reconfirmed.
- (d) This section shall not prohibit the responsible consumption of alcoholic beverages upon the municipal properties known as the “Palace Theater,” “Beaton Market Place,” “Temple Beth-El,” “Pocket Park” and the “Campbell Arts Plaza” in the Historic Downtown area, or such other municipal property as the City Council may from time to time specifically exempt from this section, provided that such consumption complies with all other applicable laws.
